How to Use This Checklist

This checklist helps UAE small business owners audit their current POS system against the Federal Tax Authority's 2026 e-invoicing requirements.

4. Priority badges guide your implementation order

Official Implementation Timeline

Phase	Business Criteria	ASP Appointment Deadline	Go-Live Deadline
Pilot	Selected Taxpayer Working Group members	N/A (Invitation only)	1 July 2026
Phase 1	≥ AED 50M annual revenue	31 July 2026	1 January 2027
Phase 2	< AED 50M annual revenue	31 March 2027	1 July 2027
Phase 3	Government Entities	N/A	1 October 2027

Cost of Non-Compliance

- **AED 5,000/month** for late ASP appointment (capped at AED 50,000)
- **AED 100/invoice** for late transmission to ASP (capped at AED 5,000/month)
- **AED 1,000/day** for failure to report system malfunctions
- Additional VAT assessments if invoices are deemed non-compliant during audit

✓ Core Compliance Checklist

Mark each item that your current POS system supports:

- Sequential & Immutable Invoice Numbering **CRITICAL**
Every invoice has a unique, chronological number with no gaps. Edits/create credit notes only—no hard deletes.

- Bilingual Receipts (Arabic/English) **CRITICAL**
Arabic text is legally mandatory on all tax invoices. System supports RTL formatting on screen and printed receipts.

- PINT-AE XML Export Capability **CRITICAL**
Generates structured XML invoices compliant with UAE Peppol Invoice Standard (PINT-AE) and MoF Data Dictionary v1.0.

- Accredited Service Provider (ASP) Integration **CRITICAL**
Can transmit validated invoices to an FTA-accredited ASP via Peppol network for official submission.

- 5-Year UAE Data Archiving **RECOMMENDED**
Encrypted storage of tax records within UAE borders for minimum 5 years, with FTA-ready retrieval.

- TRN Validation & Endpoint Resolution **RECOMMENDED**
Auto-validates customer TRNs against FTA database and resolves Peppol endpoint IDs for B2B invoices.

- Offline-First Architecture **NICE TO HAVE**
Continues processing sales during internet outages; syncs data automatically when connection restores.

- Automated Arabic Product Mapping **NICE TO HAVE**
AI-assisted translation of product names to accurate Arabic (not machine translation) for inventory and receipts.

Technical Readiness Assessment

System Integration Questions

- Can your POS export invoice data in XML format?
If yes: Is it validated against the PINT-AE XSD schema?

- Does your system support API integration with ASPs?
List compatible ASPs: _____

- Is your data stored in UAE-based data centers?
Required for compliance with data residency requirements.

- Does your POS generate SHA-256 hashes for invoice integrity?
Recommended for audit trail immutability.

Staff & Process Readiness

- Have staff been trained on bilingual receipt requirements?

- Is there a process for handling credit notes and invoice corrections?

- Do you have a backup/recovery plan for POS system failures?
